Application Procedure

Step 1: Complete the Application

Please complete the online application form on the link below. <u>https://jinis.jp/en/plan/application/</u>

Step 2: Registration Fee

Please note that a non-refundable one-time registration fee of JPY 50,000 is required. Please make a settlement of the registration fee through the link below. <u>https://jinis.jp/en/examination-fee/</u>

*Please note that Registration fees settlement can only be done by credit card *Please use the same email address entered in the application form to be registered at the payment.

Step 3: Decide the date of the Assessment.

Step 4: Submission of supporting documents

*Colour scan of the pupil's passport *Admission Assessment Entry Sheet submitted via email. *School transcript of last 12 months (Applicable for grade 2 to grade 5 enrollment)

Step 5: Assessment (On-campus /Online)

Writing Exam in English. Interview with parents or guardians. Interview with parents or guardians and pupils.

Step 6: Decision

Once we have received the completed Online Application, required documents and the result of the Assessment, we will share your child's Application with the Admission Committee. The Head and other educational team members review the Application and make the final decision on acceptance.

Step 7: Preparation for the enrollment

Once admission is granted, the JINIS admissions office will send you the acceptance letter and invoice for the enrollment fees stated in the financial information. Please settle the payment within 14 business days.



Waiting List Policy

If your child is accepted to a grade with no current vacancies, they will be placed on our waiting list. Our dedicated admissions team will promptly notify you should a vacancy become available for your child's grade. While we cannot guarantee the exact duration of your placement on the waiting list or when a space may open up at JINIS, rest assured that we'll keep you informed every step of the way.

Once admission from the waiting list is granted, you'll receive comprehensive support throughout the enrollment process from one of our experienced admission representatives.

Announcement of Decision

Decision results will be communicated exclusively via email. Kindly note that we are unable to provide assessment results over the phone. Additionally, JINIS will furnish the acceptance letter in hard copy for your records.

To secure your child's place at Jinseki International School, full payment of the enrollment fee is required within 14 business days following the acceptance date. The enrollment process will be deemed complete upon receipt of all necessary documents by the admissions office.

In the event that your admission is not granted, while we do not offer individual feedback on the assessment, our admission office will inform you if a reapplication would be accepted. Be sure to keep an eye on your inbox for updates.
